2. Composition

Lithium salts and water, pH 7 to 8

3. Hazard identification

Irritant; potential neurological effects

4. First aid measures

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes.

5. Fire fighting measures

Extinguishing Media: Carbon dioxide or dry chemical powder

6. Accidental release measures

Procedure to be followed in case of leak or spill: Clean area wearing rubber gloves. Blot liquids with paper towel and sweep up broken glass, place in a bag and hold for waste disposal. Avoid contact with substance. Avoid raising dust. Ventilate area and wash spill site after material pickup is complete.

7. Handling and storage

Do not breath aerosol. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not drink. Avoid prolonged or repeated exposure.

Storage: Keep tightly closed. Store in a cool dry place

8. Exposure controls

Engineering controls: Safety shower and eye bath.

Personal Protective equipment: Wear chemical resistant gloves, safety goggles, other protective clothing.

General Hygiene measures: Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly after handling.
